Dear Parents,

Once again we will be running a number of clubs for the Summer term.

Details of the clubs are set out below. All clubs run for 11 weeks (week beginning 21st Apr to week beginning 7th July.)

Bookings for all clubs need to be made via Arbor by 4th Apr. Most of our own staff led clubs cost £30 which is great value at about £2.70 per session.

As some clubs require a minimum number of members to run, we will advise you if a club is not running on 4th Apr. Please assume your child has a place in the club(s) you have applied for unless you are told otherwise.

Please note that when your child becomes a member of a club we would expect attendance to be every week unless they are off sick. We will assume your child will be attending every session unless you have advised the school office.

If your child is in receipt of pupil premium, then you will be able to use a voucher to the value of £25 to reduce the cost of a club. If your child is in receipt of pupil premium, please telephone the school to book your child's place. We would encourage all those who have a pupil premium voucher to sign up to one of our clubs.
