## Formation of the Policy

## Statement

At Hobbs Hill Wood Primary School, we believe that working in partnership with families is crucial to both the happiness and outcomes of our children. We use our Home School Agreement, as part of our New Pupil Information Pack, to ensure all involved are clear about their responsibilities and expectations and hope that by working together we can support the aims and values of the school.

- A home-school agreement sets out the school's aims and values; the school's responsibilities towards its pupils, the responsibilities of the pupil's parents/carers and what the school expects of its pupils.
