Communication and Language

- Sharing important events and celebrations with others.
- Understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important.
- Articulate ideas in clear phrases and sentences.
- Learn and use new vocabulary.
- Enjoy listening to longer stories and can remember much of what happens.

Personal, Social and Emotional

- Initiating play with others and extending play by sharing new ideas.
- Develop their sense of responsibility and membership of a community.
- Beginning to manage their own feelings and emotions.
- Becoming aware of other children's feelings.

Physical Development

- Holding pencils with more control making a range of marks and patterns.
- Increasingly able to use and remember sequences and patterns of movements around music.

Literacy

- Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.
- Make marks to represent words.
- Write letters in their name.

Maths

- Matching numeral and quantity
- Exploring 2D shapes
- Experiment with their own symbols and marks as well as numerals.
- Talk about and identify the patterns around them.
- Know that the last number reached when counting a set of objects tells you how many there are in total.
- Comparing quantities, identifying which has 'more than' or 'less than'.

Understanding the World

- Explore a variety of festivals and how they are celebrated.
- Talk about a festival or event they have celebrated.
- Continue to develop positive attitudes about the differences between people.
- Know that there are different countries in the world and talk about the differences they have experienced or seen in photos.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Exploring colours and how they can be changed.
- Joins a variety of materials together using glue and sellotape.
- Remember and sing entire songs.
